MAIN POLICY

Conference Registration, Cancellation & Refund Policy

1. POLICY OVERVIEW

All registrations for the 9th International Conference on Next Generation Computing and Communication Technologies (ICNGCCT 2026) are subject to the following terms. By registering, you agree to these terms in full. The policy is designed to be fair and transparent while accounting for administrative and financial commitments made by the conference organizers.

2. GENERAL REFUND ELIGIBILITY & SCHEDULE

Refund eligibility is determined by the date a written cancellation request is received by the Conference Secretariat. The conference start date is 17 December 2026.

Cancellation Notice Period	Refund Amount
Cancellation request received on or before 15 October 2026	100% refund (less USD 25 service fee)
Cancellation request received 16 October – 17 November 2026	50% refund (less USD 25 service fee)
Cancellation request received on or after 18 November 2026	No refund

3. AUTHOR-SPECIFIC REFUND CONDITIONS

- Authors may receive a refund (subject to the schedule in Section 2) only if a formal written request to withdraw their paper is received before the final manuscript is submitted for publication in the proceedings.

4. SUBSTITUTION POLICY

Registrants who are unable to attend may transfer their registration to a substitute attendee at no additional charge, provided a written request with the substitute's full name, affiliation, and email is sent to the Conference Secretariat at least 15 days before the conference begins.

5. SERVICE & PROCESSING FEE

A non-refundable administrative and processing fee of USD 25 will be deducted from all approved refunds. Additionally, the registrant is responsible for any bank charges incurred during the refund wire transfer. The net refund amount will be calculated as: [Applicable Refund % of Registration Fee] - USD 25 - Any bank charges.

6. VISA DENIALS

The conference will provide a formal Letter of Invitation to registered attendees upon request. However, obtaining a visa is the sole responsibility of the attendee. Visa-related cancellations are subject to the standard refund schedule in Section 2.

7. FORCE MAJEURE & CONFERENCE CANCELLATION/POSTPONEMENT

In the unlikely event that ICNGCCT 2026 is canceled or postponed by the Organizing Committee due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control (including but not limited to acts of God, war, terrorism, government regulation, disaster, pandemic, or venue unavailability), the following will apply:

- **REGISTRATION TRANSFER:** All registrations will be automatically transferred to the rescheduled conference dates.
- **REFUND OPTION:** If a registrant is unable to attend the rescheduled dates, they may request a refund of the registration fee (less any non-recoverable costs incurred by the organizers and the USD 25 service fee). Such requests must be made within 7 days of the postponement announcement.
- **LIABILITY LIMITATION:** The Organizing Committee, its agents, and affiliates shall not be liable for any costs, damages, or losses incurred by registrants, including but not limited to travel, accommodation, or other incidental expenses.

8. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY & PUBLICATION

By submitting a paper and/or presenting at ICNGCCT 2026, authors grant the conference organizers a non-exclusive, perpetual license to publish, archive, and distribute the work in the conference proceedings and related platforms (e.g., conference website, digital libraries). Authors retain copyright of their work.

9. PUBLICATION DISCLAIMER

- The committee may recommend registered papers to partner publication editors, but the final publication decision rests solely with the respective Publication's editorial board (Chief Editor/Editorial Committee).
- The ICNGCCT 2026 Organizing Committee assumes no liability for issues related to paper publication or database indexing.
- Any Article Processing Charges (APCs) or publication fees levied by the publishing house for selected papers must be paid directly by the authors to the respective publisher. These charges are not included in the ICNGCCT 2026 conference registration fee.

10. DATA PRIVACY

Personal information collected during registration will be used solely for conference administration (badges, proceedings, communication) and will not be sold to third parties. It may be shared with key partners (e.g., venue, publishing house) strictly for operational purposes.

11. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Attendance at ICNGCCT 2026 is at the registrant's own risk. To the maximum extent permitted by law, the Organizing Committee excludes liability for any loss, injury, illness or damage to

persons or property, including but not limited to medical expenses, travel related losses or for any indirect or consequential loss.

12. POLICY AMENDMENTS

The ICNGCCT 2026 Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend these terms at any time. The most current version will always be posted on the official conference website.

13. HOW TO REQUEST A CANCELLATION OR REFUND

All requests must be made in writing (email is required) to the official conference contact. Telephone requests will not be accepted or processed.

- **Processing Time:** Refund processing may take **4-6 weeks** from the date of written approval.

14. MEDIA RELEASE & CONSENT CLAUSE

By registering for or accepting an invitation to ICNGCCT 2026, you irrevocably grant Zelus International (the "Event Organizers") the perpetual, worldwide right to use photos, videos, and recordings from the event (including your likeness) for promotional, commercial, and archival purposes across all media. You waive all rights to inspect, approve, or receive compensation for this use. Registration to the conference constitutes acceptance of these terms. The Organizers are not liable for images taken by other attendees.

ANNEXURE A

AUTHOR & PUBLICATION GUIDELINES

A1. PAPER SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- All papers must be original work and not previously published
- Papers must follow the conference formatting guidelines
- Minimum one author must register for the conference
- Papers must be submitted by the published deadline

A2. PUBLICATION RIGHTS

- Authors retain copyright of their work
- Conference receives non-exclusive publication and distribution rights
- Authors are responsible for obtaining permissions for any third-party content
- Plagiarism or copyright violations will result in immediate disqualification
- Authors warrant that submitted papers are original, properly attributed works with substantial human intellectual contribution, and agree to indemnify ICNGCCT 2026 organizers against all claims arising from plagiarism, AI-generated content misrepresentation, or copyright infringement.

ANNEXURE B

SPONSORSHIP & EXHIBITOR TERMS & CONDITIONS

B1. SCOPE OF APPLICATION

These terms apply to all sponsorship and exhibition agreements for ICNGCCT 2026. By entering into a sponsorship agreement or making payment toward sponsorship, the sponsor agrees to be bound by these terms.

B2. PAYMENT TERMS

- **100% PAYMENT REQUIRED:** Full sponsorship payment must be received within 14 days of contract signing to secure the sponsorship tier.
- **PAYMENT BEFORE BENEFITS:** Payment must be received in full before any sponsorship benefits are activated or delivered.
- **CURRENCY & FEES:** All sponsorship fees are quoted and must be paid in USD. Sponsor is responsible for all currency conversion fees, bank charges, and wire transfer fees.
- **LATE PAYMENT CONSEQUENCES:** Late payments may result in downgrade of sponsorship tier, forfeiture of time-sensitive benefits (e.g., early branding, speaker slots), or cancellation of agreement.

B3. CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY FOR SPONSORS

Sponsorship cancellations are subject to the following refund schedule:

Cancellation Notice Period	Refund Amount
Cancellation before July 1, 2026	Full refund minus \$250 admin fee and bank charges
Cancellation July 1 - Sept 1, 2026	50% refund minus \$250 admin fee and bank charges
Cancellation after Sept 1, 2026	No refund

- **REFUND PROCESSING:** All refunds subject to 3-5% bank/transaction processing fees. Refunds will be processed within 30 business days of written cancellation request.
- **CANCELLATION REQUEST:** Must be submitted in writing to sponsor@icngcct.com with subject line "Sponsorship Cancellation - [Company Name]"

B4. SPONSORSHIP BENEFITS & DELIVERABLES

- **NON-TRANSFERABLE BENEFITS:** All sponsorship benefits are non-transferable and apply exclusively to ICNGCCT 2026. Benefits cannot be carried forward to future conferences.
- **MATERIALS DEADLINE:** October 15, 2026 is the final deadline for submission of all sponsor materials including company logos, promotional banners, booth graphics, speaker information, and marketing content.
- **LATE SUBMISSION CONSEQUENCES:** Failure to provide materials by the deadline may result in exclusion from printed materials, reduced visibility, or inability to fulfill certain benefits. No refund or compensation for missed opportunities.

- **BOOTH ASSIGNMENT:** Exhibition booth space and locations are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis following payment confirmation. Organizers reserve the right to make final booth assignments.

B5. FORCE MAJEURE & EVENT CHANGES

CONFERENCE CANCELLATION: If ICNGCCT 2026 is cancelled due to force majeure events (natural disasters, pandemics, war, terrorism, government restrictions, venue unavailability), sponsors may choose:

- **OPTION A:** Transfer sponsorship to rescheduled event (if rescheduled within 12 months from original date)
- **OPTION B:** Receive 70% refund of sponsorship amount paid (30% retained to cover non-recoverable costs and administrative expenses)
- **FORMAT CHANGES:** If conference format changes to hybrid or fully virtual, organizers will provide equivalent digital sponsorship benefits including virtual booth space, digital branding opportunities, and online speaking opportunities. No refund will be provided for format changes.

B6. LIABILITY & COMPLIANCE

- **ORGANIZER LIABILITY LIMITATION:** Maximum liability of organizers is limited to the total sponsorship amount paid by the sponsor. Organizers are not liable for sponsor's inability to attend due to travel restrictions, visa denials, illness, or personal circumstances.
- **SPONSOR RESPONSIBILITIES:** Sponsors are fully responsible for booth setup, staffing, operations, security of materials, conduct of representatives, and compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.
- **TERMINATION RIGHTS:** Organizers reserve the right to immediately terminate sponsorship for violations without refund, including harassment, discriminatory behavior, aggressive conduct, or violation of privacy rules.

ANNEXURE C

CODE OF CONDUCT

C1. PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT STANDARDS

- Plagiarism or academic dishonesty
- Misrepresentation of credentials or affiliations

C3. REPORTING & ENFORCEMENT

- Violations should be reported immediately to conference staff
- Reports will be investigated promptly and confidentially
- Violators may be expelled from the conference without refund
- Serious violations may be reported to authorities or institutions
- Conference organizers' decisions regarding violations are final

C4. PHOTOGRAPHY & RECORDING

- Conference sessions may be photographed and recorded by organizers
- Individual photography/recording requires subject consent
- Commercial photography/recording requires organizer approval
- Proprietary or confidential content should not be recorded

C5. SOCIAL MEDIA & PUBLIC COMMUNICATION

- Respect speaker requests regarding sharing of content
- Do not share confidential or proprietary information
- Maintain professional standards in all public communications
